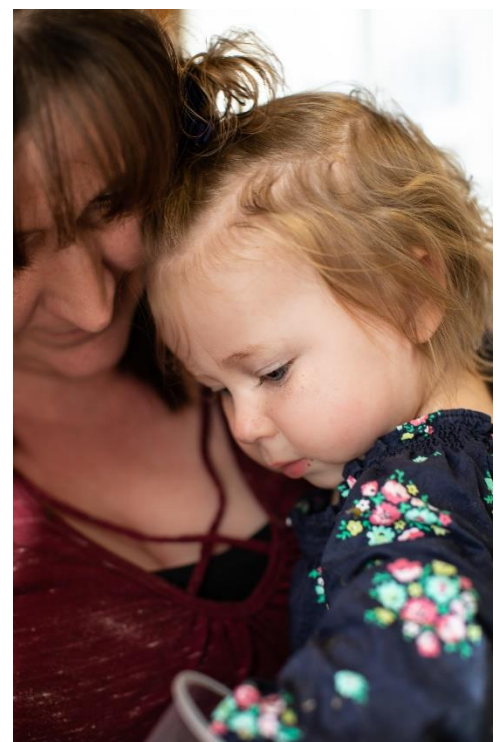

Executive Director's Message

These past two years have been an exciting time of transition and rejuvenation here at Rise. The culture of community and collaboration the Monadnock Region is known for was evident and contributed so much to Rise's success in providing comprehensive services to more children and families.

Here are a few highlights from FY18 and FY19 of how Rise used the support we received from you and other community members to improve the well-being of children and families:

- We provided more than 14,500 individual therapeutic services to children and families, a 31% increase in service delivery from the previous two fiscal years.
- Child care enrollment increased by 56% and play group enrollment by 100% through the addition of more childcare slots.
- We built a new multi-sensory play yard to allow us to better meet infant and toddler developmental needs.
- We updated some of our phone and computer systems in order to work more efficiently.
- We launched a new website.

This growth and greater service delivery was only possible because of you, our friends and partners who support this important work to advance the quality of life for infants, toddlers, and their families. We are so grateful for your generosity; together, we can ensure every child in the Monadnock Region has the best start in life.

95 children

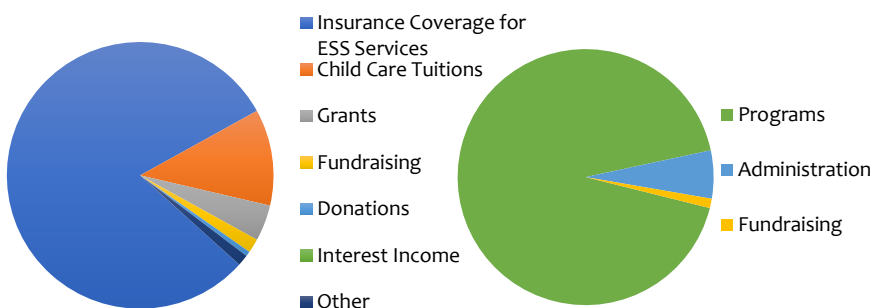
participated in playgroup, which aided in building social and emotional capacities with same-age peers in a fully inclusive setting.
