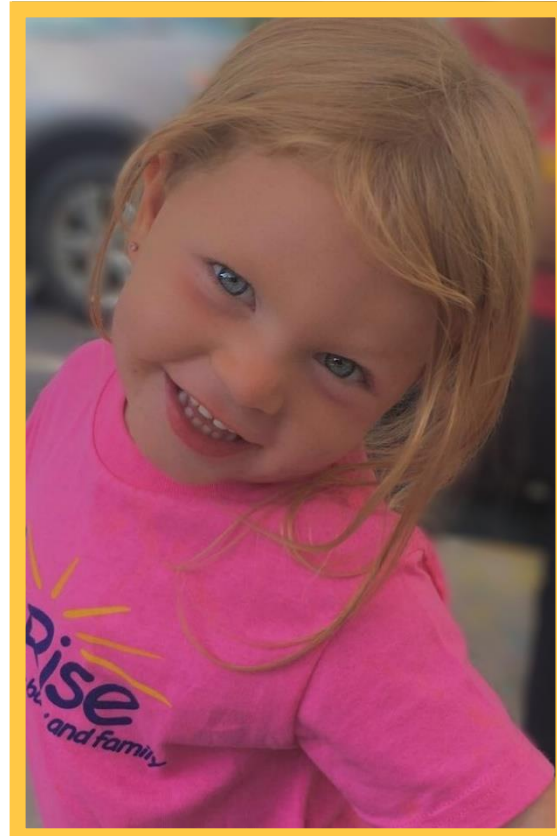

Our Mission

To support families with infants and toddlers who have or are at risk for developmental delays or disabilities through comprehensive therapeutic services that build upon the family's strengths, to provide childcare for children of all abilities, and to be a resource and advocate for inclusion throughout the Monadnock Region.

A Message from Alicia

Our 2021 fiscal year has been nothing if not challenging. From July 2020 through June 2021, we have focused on supporting families despite (and because of) the COVID restrictions we've all faced.

We have figured out ways to provide early intervention services remotely: mostly by video and occasionally by phone. As the weather improved this Spring, we were able to work with children outside. Our physical, speech, and occupational therapists, as well as our educators and our child/family counselor, have all found creative ways to support families during this unprecedented time.

At the same time, our child care staff has continued to provide a safe, loving, and creative environment for the children who come to us daily. Despite the challenges of mask wearing and extra cleaning and enhanced safety precautions, they have continued to go above and beyond their normal duties to support families.

While COVID has created many challenges for service delivery that have been overcome, we are feeling grateful for the generous donations from community members and businesses and the state and federal grants we were awarded. At this time, we anticipate around a \$67,000 loss between FY20 and FY21 due to COVID. We are feeling fortunate to have remained so financially solvent during this time.

We've just celebrated our 40th anniversary in September. This is such a milestone: 40 years of services to the communities of the Monadnock Region. As we prepare for the next 40 years, I am so proud of everyone here at Rise for all they've done for families during a year none of us could have predicted. And I am so grateful to all our supporters and to the families who trust us to care for their children. Together, we are all helping build a stronger community, one that helps every family flourish.

52 families

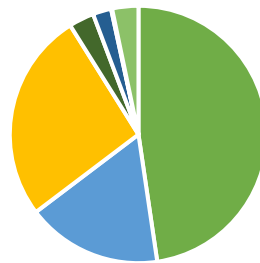
received emergency support during the COVID-19 shutdowns, thanks to generous support from local businesses, foundations, and local donors.

200 donors

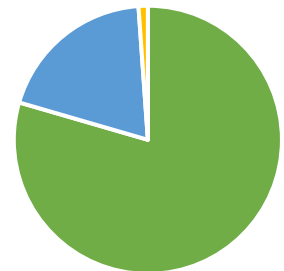
supported Rise's work, allowing us to offer additional support to families around the Monadnock Region during a very challenging year.
